

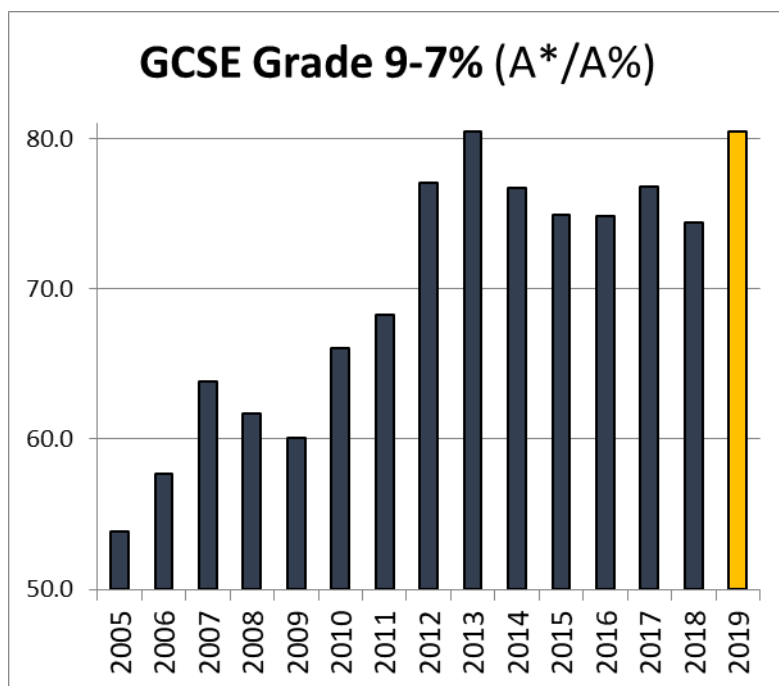

GCSE Results 2019

At King Edward VI School (K.E.S.), where students study at least ten GCSEs, over 80% papers received the top 9 to 7 grades. These record-breaking results represent the best results in Warwickshire (including both state and independent schools) and once again rank K.E.S. in the Top 10 of boys' grammar schools nationally. They come only a week after the School also achieved record-breaking results at A Level, which were also the best in Warwickshire.



Thirty students achieved five or more grade 9s. Amongst them were **Tobias Bretschneider, Luke Hayward, Rob Maundrill** and **Nilay Sah** who obtained ten, and **William West, Findlay Douglas, Sean Mata** and **Daniel Paulo** who obtained nine.
